Summary

The FARS Midyear Meeting Scholarship is intended to provide junior faculty the opportunity to participate in the Midyear Meeting.

We offer “research,” “teaching,” and in special circumstances, “restricted-travel” scholarships.

- Research scholarships are granted to faculty for whom attendance can primarily boost the attendee’s research productivity and enhance the attendee’s visibility in the research community.
- Teaching scholarships are granted to faculty for whom attendance can primarily improve the attendee’s ability to disseminate cutting-edge research findings in the classroom.
- Restricted travel scholarships may be granted to faculty who are subject to travel restrictions (e.g., restrictions due to Texas HB 3859 legislation).

Amount and reimbursement

As part of the scholarship, the meeting registration fee (including luncheon tickets) is waived. The scholarship will cover roundtrip coach (economy) class airfare (a maximum of \$400 for the 2020 Midyear Meeting) and hotel cost for two nights at the conference hotel (or less expensive hotel if the host hotel block is full). Scholarship recipients are responsible for arranging and prepaying for their airfare and hotel. Scholarship recipients will submit a reimbursement form and original receipts to the AAA at the conclusion of the Midyear meeting for reimbursement.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- Accounting faculty
- FARS member
- Received his/her PhD within the past six years
- Limited discretionary funds at their institution to attend conferences
- Must be able to attend the entire conference to be eligible for reimbursement
